The school is situated in the calm and serene atmosphere at Noneyadih, four kilometers from the Raxaul Railway Station, on the Raxaul-Adapur Nahar Road. St. Basil's School is affiliated to the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi.

REGISTRATION AND ADMISSION

1. The Academic Year of the School is from April to March

2. Admission to LKG is taken in March. Admission in other classes will be entertained only at the instance of vacancy in that class, which will be announced in April/after new session starts.

3. Prospectus and Registration Form will be available from the school office during the prescribed hours.

4. Registration fee is Rs. 500 - which is not Refundable.

Registration does not Guarantee Admission. It will be subject to Merit and availability of Seats.

I. Age:

LKG:- The child to be registered shall have completed 4 years on 1 April of the Year of Admission.

II. Birth Certificate:

Two attested photocopies of the birth certificate from the CRS portal (online) must be submitted at the time of registration.

NB: i) Date of Birth

ii) Baptism certificate in case of

• Christian children

once submitted shall not be altered at any stage later, on any account whatsoever.

ii) No other certificate will be accepted.

iii) Applications without Birth Certificate will be rejected.

III. Other Requirements and Conditions:

i. The child shall come accompanied by the parents for Registration and submission of Registration forms.

ii. Stamp size photograph should be affixed on Registration form in the appropriate columns given

iii. The interest and availability of the parents in helping the child will be counted in the selection of children for Admission.

IV. Interaction (for LKG)

i. An interaction with the child will be done on the informed date.

ii. The child brought for interaction shall be able to

- Recognize and recite English Alphabet.
- Recognize and recite Hindi Alphabet.

- Recognize and count numbers 1 to 20
- Answer questions smartly and intelligently.

- Recognize colours, flowers, animals and fruits.

ADMISSION

1. The names of the children selected for admission will be published on the School Notice Board on the given date.

2. Admission of the selected children will be taken on the assigned days.

3. Those who fail to respond shall forfeit their chance.

4. The first installment of fees shall be paid in the school office at the time of admission.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

i. Original Copy of the Birth Certificate (for verification)

ii. Medical fitness certificate (in the proforma given in the registration form)

iii. Parents of the child must be present to fill the Admission Form and sign. No representative will be entertained.

ADMISSION TO OTHER CLASSES

1. Admission in classes other than LKG depends on the availability of seats, which shall be declared after the new session starts. Notice in this regard will be given in April.

2. Prospectus will be available from the school office for the classes where vacancies fall.

3. Requirements for Registration:

i. An attested Copy of the Birth

Certificate (as in the case of LKG).

ii. Copy of the Report Card from the school last attended which shows the student is promoted to the next class (for classes I and above).

iii. Character Certificate from the School last attended.

4. Written test

Written test for classes up to VII will be Taken in Mathematics, Hindi, English and General Knowledge (which includes General Science and Social Studies) as per the syllabus of the school.

5. Registration and interaction will be taken on the prescribed day.

ADMISSION

1. Name of the eligible students will be displayed on the Notice Board.

2. Admission of the selected student will be taken on the fixed days. Those who fail to turn up will be deprived of the chance.

REQUIREMENTS AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

1. Transfer Certificate from the school last attended (for classes I and above).

2. Birth Certificate in original for verification.

3. Medical Fitness Certificate (Proforma is given with the registration form).

4. Two Passport Size photographs with parents

5. Parents of the student to be admitted shall be present to fill the form and sign. (no representative will be accepted)

6. Copy of the Aadhaar Card of the student and either parent.

7. Permanent Education Number (PEN)

from UDISE Plus.

8. APAAR ID.

9. The parents shall collect the pay in-slips from the school office and deposit the first installment of the fee at the time of admission.

CURRICULAM

The course of study followed is in accordance with the syllabus prescribed by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination (CISCE), New Delhi in order to prepare the students for the ICSE (Class 10).

English, Hindi, Mathematics, General Science. Social Studies (from class III), Moral Science and Value Education, Art and Craft, Computer (Classes III-V), Sanskrit (Class V), S.U.P.W (Socially Useful and Productive Works) and General Knowledge.

C. HIGH SCHOOL (CLASSES - VI TO X) SECTION:

English- Language and Literature, Hindi Language and Literature, Mathematics, Science (Physics, Chemistry & Biology), Sanskrit (Classes-VI to VIII), Social Science (Geography, History and Civics) Moral Science, General Knowledge, S.U.P.W (Socially Useful and Productive Works). Computer Science/Application.

FACILITIES PROVIDED

ST. BASIL'S SCHOOL, NONEYADIH provides the following facilities to maintain high standard in providing value education so that our students will surely be competent enough to withstand any competition in National level.

1. FULLY FLEDGED SCIENCE LABORATORIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GUIDANCE OF THE COUNCIL

We have spacious and sufficient number of physics, chemistry and biology laboratories with all the required apparatus and other necessary requirements to cater to the needs of students. Even students of high school classes are taken to the laboratories occasionally to make them familiar with the apparatus and system.

2. COMPUTER LAB

The school has a computer lab so that all students can make use of it. The school ensures that each student gets the opportunity to practice on a separate computer system.

3. LIBRARY

School library is renovated according to the need. It is replenished every year with additional supply of books on different subjects and different themes. Library has a spacious reading room where students can look up reference books on various topics and read newspapers and periodicals.

4. SPORTS AND GAMES

We give utmost importance to physical education and have competent, well-trained staff in this field. In addition, we have spacious playgrounds for almost all outdoor games. Physical training is compulsory for students of all sections.

5. SCHOOL BUS SERVICE

The School has School Bus Service for the commutation of students. The school bus service is available only on selected routes. No change will be made in the routes between sessions. Bus facility is not provided for a period less than 12 months (full academic session). It is an additional facility provided for students of the lower classes.

Students may be required to attend extra classes on any working day after school hours or on holidays, provided they have been informed on the previous day. Students themselves must take the alternatives for their conveyance.



FEES AND REGULATIONS

1. School Fees

1. Fees are charged for the whole calendar year. The tuition fee is to be remitted bi-monthly, that is in six installments on the prescribed dates.

2. The first installment of the new entrants will be at the time of admission.

3. All fees will be taken in the school counter only on the prescribed dates.

4. Defaulters shall remit a fine of Rs. 25/- and Rs. 50/- at the lapse of given date in the 2nd month and 3rd month of installment respectively.

5. An addition of Rs. 1/- will be charged everyday to the existing fine for the defaulters after the due dates to pay the fees with fine.

6. The student's name is liable to be struck off in case of default at the end of the respective quarter.

2. Conveyance Fees

1. Conveyance fees are charged for the 11 months of the academic year. This is to be remitted bi-monthly that's in six installments on the prescribed dates.

2. Conveyance fee will be charged for one installment even if the child stops coming in between.

3. Parents are requested to pay the fees and take the 'CONVEYANCE PASS CARD' at beginning of every prescribed date. The bus facility arranged by the school. Fees will be taken only in the school counter.

4. Defaulters shall remit a fine of Rs. 25/- and Rs. 50/- at the lapse of given date in the 2nd month and 3rd month of installment respectively.

5. Children must travel only in their allotted buses. If a change of bus is required for any reason, a written application must be submitted to the office and approved by the Principal.

6. To ensure uninterrupted conveyance service, there must be no outstanding dues at the end of each quarter.



GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLINE

- Students are supposed to maintain discipline by being well mannered, polite and well behaved in all their activities inside as well as outside the school premises. Students shall strictly adhere to the guidelines, rules and regulations stipulated by the school management.
- Be decent and modest in your uniform, wearing neat and clean dress. You shall strictly abide by the instructions regarding hairstyle. Girls should use proper hair band or ribbon as directed by the principal/class teacher. Boys shall have proper haircut and comb the hair. Use of ornaments is not entertained. Nails should be properly trimmed.
- Students shall not bring electronic gadget of any kind, other materials, books and stationery not approved by the principal to the school campus. School management will have the right to confiscate such things.
- School will not take any responsibility of loss of property including study material. Students must take responsibility to keep their personal belongings safe and without being lost. Students are allowed to bring money to school only if asked by the competent authority. No monetary collection is made without the approval of the principal.
- But at the same time they should bring with them necessary articles for their daily work, lunch and other necessary items. No request for handing anything over to the students during the school hours will be accepted.
- Absolute silence must be observed during the morning assembly and also while moving in and out of the classroom, even in the absence of teachers. During the recess students shall not behave viciously.
- English is the medium of instruction in our school and students should speak English in the school campus when they interact each other and interact with the teachers.
- Students should not write, carve or scratch on the school walls or deface the school furniture by any means. The students are bound to make good any damage done to the school property of any sort.
- Bullying of any type including physical assault or verbal abuse direct or through social media will be considered as serious indiscipline. Such practice even outside the school campus will be considered as serious indiscipline. Such practice even outside the school campus will lead to grave disciplinary action.



GUIDELINES TO PARENTS

- 1. Please send the children in neat and modest dress.**
- 2. Make sure they follow the instructions of the school in dressing, hairstyle, nail trimming and other important matters.**
- 3. Please make sure that they do not ride motor vehicles violating the rules of our country. Taking precaution is always better than repenting afterwards.**
- 4. Please do not approach any academic staff of the school for private tuition, School as a matter of fact does not promote or encourage private tuition.**
- 5. Give them money only when needed and also make sure that they do not take money without your knowledge.**
- 6. Allow only a judicious use of mobile phone. Please make sure that they go to only those websites that will promote learning. Dont allow them to take mobile phone to school.**
- 7. Parents are requested to cooperate with the school when the child is asked to participate in co-curricular activities.**



ATTENDANCE

Attendance 80% or above is required in all the classes up to class eight. For classes nine and above the rules and regulations of CISCE New Delhi to which the school is affiliated will be followed.

In case of medical emergency, leave application must be supported with necessary documents in original.

Students will not be allowed to leave the school premises during the school hours. In case of emergency the students must inform the class teacher and class teacher shall convey the matter to principal. In case of emergency, parents must contact the school office.

Latecomers and absentees will not be admitted in the class without the express sanction of the principal.



EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

The promotion to next class is decided through a system of continuous assessment throughout the year. Written examination of each semester, class tests, assignments, project work and other, criteria decided by the principal will be taken into consideration in the process of promotion to next class. There will be no re-examination or examination out of schedule.

Participation in physical education and other co-curricular activities when asked is compulsory no exemption will be granted in this regard.

No leave will be sanctioned during the examination.

A student who is unsuccessful for two consecutive years is not eligible to continue and will be asked to leave the school.

Any grievance with regard to the promotion must be addressed to the principal only.
